

The Local Community

The local people are very poor subsistence farmers, struggling to feed their families on manually cultivated crops from their smallholdings. Most live in small mud huts with no running water or electricity. Some travel more than 80 miles for help. The hospital, which celebrated its Golden Jubilee in 2008, derives only a small proportion of its income from the Ugandan Government. Patients have to pay for their care but because they are so poor, the hospital has to keep user fees to a bare minimum and the shortfall in running costs needs to be made up by charitable donations. **Kisiizi Partners** also has a sponsorship scheme for orphaned children: Sponsor An Orphan.

Every year the hospital treats:-

- 37,000 outpatients
- 10,500 inpatients
- 2000 babies delivered
- 14,000 children immunised
- 1200 X-rays
- 2200 operations

All with a staff of 60 nurses, 6 doctors and 6 clinical officers.

The Challenge of Rural Healthcare

Africa is different. There are huge inequalities in healthcare provision between the UK and Africa, with further inequalities between rural areas and large cities. Healthcare staff often prefer to work in larger centres at the expense of rural areas where many people suffer as a result of scanty provision, with long distances between health facilities and inadequate means of transport. **Kisiizi Partners** (formerly Sponsor a Nurse) is working to redress this imbalance by supporting Kisiizi Hospital, a Church of Uganda hospital situated in a remote valley in south west Uganda, seven hours' drive from the capital city, Kampala, and more than an hour away from the nearest tarmac road.

How you can Help

You can give by regular standing order or one off gift to ensure the provision of healthcare to a very poor and needy community.

£5 would pay for a nurse for a day, treat a child with malaria or treat a psychiatric patient for a fortnight.

£10 would cover the cost of a safe hospital birth or provide post-operative care for 2 days.

£100 would pay for a nurse for a month or a doctor for a week.
